General Rules - All Members

Extreme Weather Policy

Dangerous weather

...includes lightning, extreme heat and severe winds.

The Match Committee will in the event of lightning, severe winds or extreme heat, suspend or abandon play in the competition of the day.

However, should any player consider there is danger from lightning or adverse weather in the area, he or she should discontinue play until it is safe to resume. That is, an individual player's judgement can overrule that of the match committee.

If a player discontinues play they must still return their scorecard to the clubrooms.

Heat

There is no specific temperature at which a Golf Competition will be cancelled as our starting times are in the coolest part of the day and may well finish before the hottest part of the day. All members can make their own decisions to play, be it 9 holes to finish out of the heat or 18 holes to complete a full round.

The Match Committee/Captain will always have the option of cancelling play if they feel conditions are considered unbearable or dangerous.

The Match Committee is however obligated to provide the right advice before play on potentially hot days. This will consist of warnings when the ambient temperature is likely to rise above 30 degrees during play. On these days the Club will provide warnings that:

- Hydration is necessary

- Light clothing is necessary

- Shade is necessary

All players need to keep an eye on each other for signs of Heat Stress.

Wind / Lightning / Other

In the event of extreme conditions an air horn will be sounded to indicate the temporary suspension of play

SIREN NOTIFICATION PROCEDURES

1. Suspension of play

Suspension of play will be signalled by Three (3) blasts (repeated) of the siren. Play may continue to the completion of the current hole, or balls may be marked if completion is not practicable. Players should return to the Clubhouse until further notice and await advice on resumption.

2. Emergency Evacuation

One (1) continuous blast of the siren.
Players should cease play immediately and return to the Clubhouse.

3. Resumption of Play

Two (2) short blasts of the siren.
Players should return to their positions immediately and resume play.

Golf Course information & Etiquette

Safety Issues

Take care on the areas where paths and steps are badly worn, eroded due to rain or are slippery from moisture. When teeing off from the second hole, ask the group playing the first to give the all clear if you are not sure where the players in front are.

Call Ups

Players are encouraged to call up the group behind on the following holes: 7th, 9th, 16th, 18th. All players in the group calling up must stand in a safe position at the rear of the green.

Right of Way on Fairways

In the interest of speedy play the forward group has right of way on all fairways. Eg if you play a ball from the sixth tee to the fifth fairway, those playing the fifth must give right of way to prevent delays.

Pace of Play

If your group is falling behind the group in front, encourage the first two of your group who've completed the hole to proceed to the next hole and tee off. It is the responsibility of your group to maintain your position behind the group in front. If your group has fallen behind by more than a hole and you are delaying the group behind you must call the latter group through as soon as further delays become evident. The lowest handicapper in each group is responsible for maintaining the pace of play. Penalties will apply for non-observance.

Players searching for a ball have 3 minutes to locate the ball once they arrive at the place they believe it went to. Should a player be in doubt of the status of his ball being lost or out of bounds then the player is encouraged to hit a provisional ball. As soon as it becomes evident that a ball is lost or shall not be easily located then they should signal the group behind to play through. Having allowed the group to play through, they should not continue play until that group is no longer in range of their next shot.

Members are requested not to leave Golf Bags, Carts or Buggies unattended at the front of the green as this can often delay the group behind and as such may constitute slow play (Ref, rule 6.7 Undue delay) The match committee has adopted the use of local model rule E-5. For details of relief options, refer to USGA rules of golf 2019.

Care of Course

All members are advised to carry sand buckets and where applicable and when not in contravention of the rules of golf make repairs to divot marks on the course. A pitch mark repair tool should also be carried in order to repair any ball marks made on the green putting surface. Golf Carts and Buggies are not permitted on tee grounds or greens

Bunkers

Before leaving a bunker, players should carefully fill up and smooth over all holes and footprints made by themselves and nearby by others.

Putting Green Etiquette

Players shall not use the blade of their putter or stand within 200mm of the edge of the hole when retrieving the ball from the cup. When putting players are encouraged to promptly announce their intention to continue or delay their next putt by stating "I shall mark it" or "I will continue" after an unsuccessful putt.

GPS Devices

In accordance with VGL Rules, Legal distance measuring devices are allowed to be used whilst playing competition rounds at Riverside Essendon Club events including all sanctioned VGL Events. Mobile Phones with Apps are also allowed provided they do not have access to measure the velocity or direction of the wind.

Complaints/Disputes

Any valid complaint/dispute regarding golfing matters must be lodged in writing to the match committee no later than 24 hours following the competition of the event at which the matter arose.

SUMMER CUP CONDITIONS

The Summer Cup will commence in November for **12 weeks for Women.**

The Summer Cup will commence in November for **12 weeks for Men.**

Players must pay a \$10 entry fee to cover prizes. The completed entry form and fee must be handed to the respective Captain or Vice-Captain prior to competing. The event is over 9 holes of Stableford on Fridays/Saturdays/Sundays.

Please note- as per Rule 7.1b Rules of Golf- a player must not practice on the competition course. That is you can only play in one competition on any day (not a 9 hole & an 18 hole competition on the same day).

Competition will be played off Yellow Public markers using GA handicaps. eg use rounding 29.4 =29, 29.5 =30

Players to mark cards as Holes 1 – 9. The best Stableford score for the combined each Friday's/Saturday's/Sunday's competition will be awarded a prize for that's weeks Event.

Cards must be signed & placed in the club mailbox (on the front gate to the clubrooms) by dark on the Sunday of each round. Please note: As per Rule Selection for Qualification for Finals shall be Eight (8) players with the Best Aggregate Score over the Best Six (6) Rounds of a possible 12 Rounds in the Event. It is not compulsory to have played Six (6) rounds to qualify. The top Eight (8) Qualifiers will play Elimination Stableford Rounds.

In the event of a Tie for Eighth Position, the player with the Best Single Round will Qualify. (see below if actual score is the same for the Best Single Round)

If two or more players are Tied for any of the Qualifying Positions, the player with the Best single round will qualify for the best position of the draw.

If the Player's Actual Scores are the same for the Best Single Round, then a Countback will apply and shall continue on this process for each of the next five (5) Best Single Rounds until positions are decided.

If by chance a decision is not reached after checking the best six (6) rounds then all tied Players names to go into a draw with first drawn etc to take the Best Qualifying Position.

If during any Finals of Summer Cup Matches, a game is Drawn on Stableford Points then a Sudden Death Playoff is to commence immediately from the 1st Hole.

MONTHLY MEDALS

Medals will be played over 18 holes of stroke play using Golf Australia Handicaps

Women - the maximum GA handicap is 54.0

Men - the maximum GA handicap is 54.0

In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by Countback.

To be eligible to win a monthly medal the participant must be a financial member of the Riverside Golf Club (Essendon) Inc.

MIXED FOURSOMES/JOAN & JIM MCCALLUM MEMORIAL

This event is conducted over 18 holes of stroke play with Gross and Nett winners using Golf Australia handicaps. In the event of a tie between two or more pairs, the tie will be decided by a count back.

The Joan McCallum Memorial trophy winner is the mixed pair with the best nett result on the day of competition (gross winners are also eligible to win the nett event). Riverside Club Members will be eligible for both the Gross and Nett competition.

INAUGURAL CUP

The Inaugural cup celebrates first official competition was played after the Club Name changed from Essendon Golf Club to the Riverside Golf Club (Essendon) Inc. This event will be conducted over 18 holes of stroke play using Golf Australia handicaps, with gross and nett winners. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the tie will be decided by a count back.

The Gross winner cannot win the Nett event.

Women's Competition Conditions

GENERAL

A person who is financial and has a handicap is eligible to enter events that any other member of the club who is financial and has a current handicap is also able to enter. Note: the Club Championship has its own specific eligibility criteria. Players will be required to pay the correct green fees and any competition fee as determined by the committee before commencing play. Players who have been found to have competed without paying fees will be disqualified from the competition.

Each player, before commencing play, will report to the Tee-Master 15 minutes before their tee time and enter their name on the daily competition sheet. Failure to do so shall result in Disqualification. The player shall also enter their name, handicap and date on top of their scorecard and register to play in the MiClub System. All competition events will be played off Golf Australia Handicaps.

Before commencing play, it is the player's responsibility to ascertain their correct handicap and read the notice board for temporary local rules or any other notices affecting competition.

All players MUST hand in cards at the completion of each round whether round completed or not, with special attention being paid to the correctness of their score, applied handicap and correctly signed.

Competition Grades are A & B (where competitions have 20 or more entered otherwise one grade), these grades are set at the start of each season.

For a competition to take place there must be a minimum of 5 players entered. If there are 4 players or less score cards will be processed on MiClub. If this occurs on a Major Event Day the competition where possible, will be rescheduled to a date determined by the Match Committee.

For Major Events there must be a minimum of 5 players who have nominated for the relevant competition day ie Saturday or Wednesday. For all Stroke events with Gross or Nett the Gross winner cannot win the Nett event.

Tee Placements: Major Events/Monthly Medals- Red Markers

All other events (inc Mon/Wed Competition) – Green Markers

Women's Competition Conditions cont...

Nominating Major Event Day

New members are required to advise the committee of their nominated Major Events Day (Wed or Sat) when joining the club. The Major Events Day can be changed at the start of each season and in extenuating circumstances only. The Match Committee will consider a written application to change nominated day during a season. If the change is made mid-year the player forfeits the right to win any future major event including medal of medallist and matchplay of their prior Major Event Day

PENNANT COMPETITION

Riverside Golf Club participate in the VGL Pennant Competition. Pennant games are played on Mondays from late February to late April. The team will consist of five players each side with other players in reserve. Members must wear club attire during competition.

MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIPS

Players will be required to complete a special Wednesday or Saturday entry form and submit seven (7) days prior to their respective date of Matchplay 1st Round to the Captain or Vice-Captain. A blind draw will be conducted to determine matches to be played. On the day of initial competition, players not entered will play a Single Match Play Event amongst themselves. Matches will be played using Golf Australia Handicaps from the Red Course Tees over 18 holes of Matchplay as per the Stableford/Par Index. Competition will be decided on a last player standing basis. In the event of a tie, matches will continue on and be decided by a sudden death playoff. Rounds must be completed by the dates as listed on the event result sheet. A player/players failing to complete a match by the cutoff date shall be eliminated from the Matchplay Competition.

Women's Competition Conditions cont...

WOMEN'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

To be eligible to compete in Women's Club Championships, a lady member must have been a financial member of the Club for at least 3 months and have played 3 Riverside competition rounds in the preceding 2 months of which at least one shall be in each preceding month, or 8 rounds in the previous 9 months. These events must be completed Riverside events or events representing the Riverside Club eg Pennant, Bowls etc.

There will be a separate Club Championship event for Wednesday and Saturday members. Players will be required to complete a special Wednesday or Saturday entry form and submit 7 days prior to their respective date of Championship 1st Round to the Captain or Vice-Captain. Telephone entries will not be accepted. There must be a minimum of 2 players for a competition to be held. If 20 players or more enter the championship Grades will be A, B and C. If less than 20 players, Grades will be A and B. Players will be placed in respective grades according to handicap ranges determined by the match committee when entries are received.

All players must correctly enter the competition on each of the three weeks to avoid disqualification from the overall event.

The Championships will be conducted over a 54 hole aggregate stroke competition with the winners being decided by the best Gross and best Nett scores in each grade for Wednesday and Saturday. In the event of a tie (GROSS only) between 2 or more players in any Grade there will be an 18 hole play-off. The Nett Champions will be the players with the best nett scores for their respective days. In the event of a tie (NETT only), the tie will be decided by countback. The Gross winner cannot win the Nett event. The Wednesday and Saturday Club Champions will be the players with the best gross score for their respective days. The player with a GA handicap of sub 18.5 will represent the club in the VGL League Champion of Champions event, if both players have a sub 18.5 GA handicap a play-off will be required to determine the player to represent the club. All Match Committee decisions will be final.

Women's Competition Conditions cont...

FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Foursomes Championship will be conducted over 18 holes of stroke using Golf Australia handicaps. Players will be required to complete a special Wednesday only entry form and submit 7 days prior to their respective date of Foursomes Event to the Captain or Vice-Captain.

In the event of a tie between two or more teams the tie will be decided by a count back. The Nett winners represent the club at the VGL Foursomes Championships on Monday 24th August at Southern Golf Club

PRESIDENT'S TROPHY

The event will be conducted over 18 holes of Stableford using Golf Australia handicaps. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the tie will be decided by a countback.

CAPTAIN'S TROPHY

This event will be conducted over 18 holes using the Stableford scoring system using Golf Australia handicap. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the tie will be decided by a count back.

MEMORIAL DAY

This event is played in recognition and respect for members who have passed away. It is an 18 hole Stableford event played off Golf Australia handicaps. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the tie will be decided by a count back.

Women's Competition Conditions cont...

N/W INTERCLUB

The North West Interclub is a Matchplay comp played amongst golf clubs in the North West region of Melbourne. Teams are five players per team.

MEDAL OF MEDALLISTS

The eight monthly medal winners for Wednesday competition will play off for the Wednesday winner over eighteen holes of stroke play using Golf Australia handicaps.

The eight monthly medal winners for Saturday competition will play off for the Saturday winner over eighteen holes of stroke play using Golf Australia handicaps.

In the event of a tie between two or more players, the tie will be decided by a count back.

PICNIC PAR

Is organised during off season in Dec to late Jan. See notice board for details.

Men's Competition Conditions

GENERAL

A person who is financial and has a handicap is eligible to enter events that any other member of the club who is financial and has a current handicap is also able to enter. Note: the Club Championship has its own specific eligibility criteria. Players will be required to pay the correct green fees and any competition fee as determined by the committee before commencing play. Players who have been found to have competed without paying fees will be disqualified from the competition.

Each player, before commencing play, will report to the Tee-Master 15 minutes before their tee time and enter their name on the daily competition sheet. Failure to do so shall result in Disqualification. The player shall also enter their name, handicap and date on top of their scorecard and register to play in the MiClub System. All competition events will be played off Golf Australia Handicaps.

Before commencing play, it is the player's responsibility to ascertain their correct handicap and read the notice board for temporary local rules or any other notices affecting competition.

All players MUST hand in cards at the completion of each round whether round completed or not, with special attention being paid to the correctness of their score, applied handicap and correctly signed.

In the event the MiClub System is unavailable all players are required to show a total Stableford points score as well as strokes taken for all stroke events.

Competition Grades are "A Grade 0-18" and "B Grade 19-36"

Tee Placements: Major Events/Monthly Medals- Blue Markers

All other events – White Markers

GOLDEN PUTTER TROPHY

Awarded to the player with the lowest average putts, calculated on all monthly medals/masters trophy competitions using the best 5 rounds.

EAGLE'S NEST

Eligibility for winning the Eagle's Nest is dependent on participation in Club competitions played off Club markers. The Eagles Nest runs on a 12 months basis and recommences at the beginning of each year.

Men's Competition Conditions ...cont...

ECLECTIC TROPHY

Winner decided by best gross score per hole over all rounds of monthly medals/masters trophy competitions. A minimum of 5 rounds to qualify

MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIPS

Participants will be required to ENTER by filling out an Entry Form.

Entry Forms shall be available in the Clubrooms at the start of February

Matches will be played using Golf Australia Handicaps from the Blue Course Tees over 18 Holes of Match Play as per the Match Play Index.

Competition will be decided on a last man standing basis.

In the event of a tie, match will continue on and be decided by a sudden death playoff.

Rounds must be completed by the dates in the Syllabus. A player(s) failing to complete a match by the cutoff date shall be eliminated from the Matchplay Competition. Allowances can be made for players with VGL pennant obligations by Men's Sub-Committee.

Initial competitor selection shall be conducted by a blind draw with the first 32 Players Drawn Out being entered in the Competition and any remaining Players will be listed as an emergency in order as then drawn out.

On the day of Initial Competition, Players not selected as above will play a Single Match Play Event amongst themselves.

MEMORIAL TROPHY

This event is played in recognition and respect for members who have passed away. It is an 18 hole Par event played off Golf Australia handicaps. A grade and B grade winners are awarded a trophy on presentation night and have their names recorded on the club honour board.

PRESIDENT'S TROPHY

The event will be conducted over 18 holes of Stableford using Golf Australia handicaps. In the event of a tie between two or more players, the tie will be decided by a countback.

Men's Competition Conditions ...cont...

CAPTAIN'S TROPHY

This event will be conducted over 18 holes of Par. In the event of a tie between 2 or more players, the winner will be decided by countback.

FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP

This event will be held over 18 holes of stroke play with a gross and nett winner. In the event of a tie between two or more pairs, the winners will be decided by countback. In the nett events, Golf Australia Handicaps must be used.

PENNANT COMPETITION

Riverside Golf Club participate in the VGL Handicap Pennant Competition. The team will consist of EIGHT players each side with other players in reserve. The Pennant Match committee will pick the teams on the Thursday night practice session before each round.

Members must wear club attire during competition, which consists of White Polo shirt with Riverside emblem, navy or black trousers/shorts with white socks and Riverside cap.

Members are reminded that consuming alcohol on course whilst pennant is being played shall result in Riverside being disqualified.

JACK CUFFE RIVERSIDE TEAMS TROPHY – 4 Ball Ambrose

Teams shall consist of four members. Teams can enter prior to or on the day. Players who do not enter a team will be allocated a team on the day by the Tee master. Each Team shall elect a captain for the day; and the order each member plays in at the first tee shall be maintained throughout play. The Captain has the final decision as to which ball to play at any time. Each team will record the use of at least four tee shots from each member. Ties will be decided by countback. Each player must putt out except when it is not possible for players to better the existing score.

Men's Competition Conditions ...cont...

MEN'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

Entries close at 2pm on the Sunday prior to the first round of Championships. Entries to be submitted by email to the men's sub-committee. Championships will be conducted in four handicap Grades, "A", "B", "C", and "D". Players will be placed in respective grades by the match committee. Championships will be conducted over a 72 hole aggregate stroke competition with the winner being decided by the best gross and best nett scores in each grade. In the event of tie (gross) between two or more players, there will be a 5 hole playoff from the 1st hole to the 5th. If still tied, the winner will be decided by sudden death. Playoffs must commence on the day as close to 2pm as practicable. Nett winners decided by countback. Riverside Golf & Tennis Centre Trophy winner decided by the best nett score from the Club Championship 72 Hole event in October. All grades are eligible and all other Club Championship rules apply. Players must correctly enter the competition on each of the four weeks, to avoid disqualification from the overall event.
